Rules & Regulations

1. General Compliance

All exhibitors must comply with the Needville Youth Fair General Rules.

2. Tag-In Requirements

- All swine must be officially tagged on Saturday, January 10, 2026, from 7:30
 9:00 a.m.
- o This marks the official start of the project.
- o Exhibitors may tag either a gilt or barrow.
- o Family tagging is allowed per General Rule 9.

3. Check-In Limitations

Each exhibitor may bring only one (1) hog to official check-in at the fair.

4. Weigh-In Guidelines

- o Each hog will be weighed **once** under the chairman's direction.
- A 3-pound variance is permitted.
- If a hog does not meet weight requirements, it will be immediately reweighed
 once, only after rebalancing the scale.
- Weight limits: 225 295 pounds.

 Hogs that do not make weight must be removed from the fairgrounds immediately.

5. Class Breaks

o Hogs will be divided into no more than **four (4) weight classes** for judging.

6. Sale Order & Lots

- o **22 pigs** will qualify for the sale.
- After Grand and Reserve Champions are selected, first-place animals will be placed to determine sale rotation order.
- o This rotation continues until all sale lots and alternates are placed.

7. Grooming Restrictions

- Only water is allowed for cleaning.
- No grooming products may be used at show time.

8. Animal Containment

 Once checked in, animals may not be removed from the fenced fairgrounds for any reason.

9. Clipping Policy

Only **touch-up clipping** is allowed on NYF grounds during the fair.

10. Final Authority

All decisions made by the **Division Chairman and/or Co-Chairman are final**.
